

## Conditions of use of the *thawte*® Second Tier Seal

### Who can use the Second Tier Seal?

Any person, or company who uses a valid *thawte* SSL Web Server certificate or SGC SuperCert for their top level domain, is welcome to display the relevant *thawte* Second Tier Seal on their web site.

You may only use the *thawte* Second Tier Seal on pages where the top level domain is the same as your SSL certificate. (eg. [www.domain.com](http://www.domain.com) and [www.example.com](http://www.example.com) do not share the same top level domain. The top level domains in these examples are domain.com and example.com respectively)

### Alterations to Second Tier Seals

You may not alter the *thawte* Second Tier Seals displayed on the Site Seals page.

### Prohibited Use

The *thawte* Second Tier Seal may not be used in any way that will mislead Internet users into believing that a web page or web site is secure, when in fact it is not.

### Intellectual Property Rights

The name "*thawte*" is the registered trademark of *thawte* Consulting (Pty) Ltd, a VeriSign and any company other than Company, *thawte* Consulting (Pty) Ltd has no rights in and to the name "*thawte*", and to its various logos and site seals, and may only use them as specified in these Conditions of Use.

### Optional Text to Use with the Second Tier Seal

If you qualify to use the Second Tier Seal you may use the following text to explain its use:

" Secure transactions for this website are done via (insert domain) who use a *thawte* certificate to ensure secure transmission of your information."
